The Almosenberg business park in Wertheim covers 46 hectares (460,000 m²). This places major demands on the outdoor electrical cabinet installed there, which operates independently as the central communications hub for the entire area. Up to 480 customers are connected to the fibre-optic network at the same time - including Wertheim Village, Warema Sonnenschutztechnik and others. The cabinet contains state-of-the-art fibre-optic technology, FTTH (fibre to the home) and a Rittal heat exchanger for temperature control. It has now been retrofitted with an R-AMFE for remote activation.

Jochen May, Group Manager at Stadtwerke Wertheim, is pleased with the new fire protection solution, which enables online monitoring of all distribution points: 'Installing the AMFE is an important step in preventing a total outage. Replacement lead time for the technology in the cabinet is approximately 26 months. The AMFE automatic miniature fire extinguishing unit provides a safe solution that activates automatically in the event of a fire. Operation and installation are straightforward and can easily be handled by our technicians.'
